WeatherNation No Longer Available on DIRECTV August 1

DENVER, July 30, 2018 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- [WeatherNation TV](#), Inc., a multi-format 24/7 local and national television weather news provider, was informed this week that AT&T/DIRECTV will no longer carry WeatherNation TV on Aug. 1.

“We’d like to thank the countless viewers that view our service day-in and day-out on DirecTV,” added Norton. “Thank you for sharing with us what WeatherNation means to you and what you love about WeatherNation, but most of all, thank you for letting us be the service you depended on daily. We will continue to focus on providing the most robust, all-weather news and information channel available in the market.”
